



Peter R. DeVries solves Natalee Holloway Case

**PROSECUTOR OPENS NEW INVESTIGATION AFTER
UNDERCOVER CAMERA OPERATION BY CRIME REPORTER**

Hilversum, January 31, 2008 - Crime Reporter Peter R. DeVries of Holland has solved the mystery of teenager Natalee Holloway's disappearance in Aruba. This case, which held the U.S., The Netherlands and Aruba in its thrall for three years will be solved in a must-see broadcast on SBS 6 on Sunday Night February 3, 9.30 p.m. CET.

DeVries returned last week from Aruba where he informed the authorities about his incriminating findings. The chief public prosecutor of Aruba directly started a new preliminary investigation by an examining judge, which is equivalent to a pre-trial investigation in the United States.

- UNDERCOVER CAMERA OPERATION -

The case was cracked by an elaborate undercover camera operation, worked on for months by DeVries and his staff.

- MOTHER OF NATALEE VISITS CRIME REPORTER -

The mother of Natalee Holloway, Beth Twitty, arrived in The Netherlands today on the invitation of Peter R. DeVries and has been informed about the breakthrough in the case of her daughter's disappearance.
